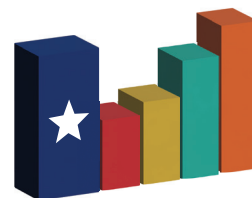


## ANGELICA OCHOA

As a dedicated and detail-oriented accounting professional, I have been meeting the accounting needs of small businesses and non-profit organizations for the past 15 years. I am currently working as a consultant for several clients in the San Antonio and Austin area. I specialize in providing financial services which consist of accounting system setup, process and procedures, analyzing financial data, preparation of Financial Statements, future forecast cost and revenue, advise on improving profitability and compliance. I attended and graduated with a degree in Accounting from UIW in San Antonio.

I started in the accounting industry while attending UIW and took on a role as an SBA loan analyst for J.P Morgan Chase in 2002 where I developed long-term trusting relationships with clients reviewing their financials and restructuring their SBA loans. I worked as part of a team to full fill all necessary tasks requiring auditing financials and necessary reporting to achieve goals to reduce loss of defaulted SBA loans. In 2007, I made a move to Clear Channel Communications as a Credit and Collections Manager for their Radio Division. In this role I was able to reduce receivable delinquency by 5.9 million on a 7.2 mil aging sitting in over 120. I lead the credit and collections department by developing policies and procedures, mentoring and training staff. I then moved into a new role as a Commissions Analyst. This department was centralizing into corporate from the markets. I helped start up the department and assisted with SQL reporting for Microsoft Dynamics to process commissions for over 185,000 employees across the US while resolving commission issues with various Market level CFO or controllers.

After leaving Clear Channel I took on a role as a Controller for a transit company based out of Monterrey Mexico. I oversaw the accounting department, Billing, Collections, AP and Payroll. Worked with Junior Accountants on closing process and intercompany transactions. Prepared financial statements, intercompany journals, audited 1.3 million weekly payrolls before process. After my time of two years, I elected to leave Corporate America and started working as a consultant. I have served as a controller on the go and have several clients in the San Antonio and Austin area. I currently work with several non-profit organizations, and I am responsible for the auditing of books, month end, payroll, 401K, payroll tax, financial statements, Yearend process. I analyze all incoming and outgoing transactions, ensuring all records are accurate for the summarizing of analyzed financial documents for presentation to board/CFO. I have several other clients I assist with their collections and startup of their books and or migration from one software to another.
